

In collaboration with our raw material suppliers, we have found a solution for sourcing our primary zinc with a smaller footprint. With ECO ZINC, we now offer our zinc products with a significantly reduced carbon footprint. This year, we received the Suppliers Sustainability Award from VARTA AG for this outstanding commitment. In this way, we support our customers in achieving their own sustainability goals. The award underlines the fact that it is precisely this commitment that is demanded and recognized by our customers. Together, we have to do everything we can to make an even greater contribution to sustainable battery technologies in the future.
